The organization

The Professional's responsibilities will include, but not be limited to, teaching lessons and clinics to both junior and adult players of all abilities, helping to organize the junior clinic program, pro shop administration and general communication with membership, traveling to tournaments, organization of Club and national tournaments and to generally enhance the member experience by proactively engaging the membership in all things squash related.
